BLUE & GOLD DANCE Saturday, October 2

Dear JBS Families,

The next big event for sophomores, juniors and seniors is the Blue & Gold Dance, Saturday, October 2. We want all Burroughs students to have a healthy, safe and enjoyable experience at such school-sponsored functions, and hope you will use this event as an opportunity to talk with your children about safe driving and the dangers and legal issues surrounding the use of alcohol and illicit drugs. We also hope that you will encourage your children to arrive in a timely manner to enjoy the dance in its entirety and to show appreciation for the work of student and parent organizers.

Following are the basic parameters and guidelines for the Blue & Gold Dance, some set by the Administration and some by Student Congress. We will review these with all sophomores, juniors and seniors in advance of the dance.

- TIME/DATE: 8:30 to 11 pm, Saturday, October 2 ~ no one will be admitted afer 10.
- LOCATION: Quad ~ Haertter Hall foyer and the Commons will be the rain sites.
- WHO'S INVITED: JBS 10th, 11th and 12th graders
- GUESTS: JBS students may each bring one guest. For guests outside the Burroughs community, a permission slip with vaccination information must be on file with Casie Tomlinson, our school nurse by Wednesday, September 29. If a guest violates a school rule, the Burroughs host will be disciplined.
- COST: Every JBS student who attends will be storecarded \$15; they will also be charged for a non-JBS guest.
- LATE ARRIVAL FEES: Per Student Congress, late arrival fines will be imposed: Between 9:01 and 9:30 pm, the fee will be \$5 and between 9:31 and 10 pm, the fee will be \$10. Late fees can only be paid in cash—no storecarding.
- PARKING & CHECK-IN: All students (and guests) must check in. This process helps the dance chaperones keep track of how many students and guests are present, take attendance and collect fees when appropriate. Students should park in the Clayton

Road parking lot because they must enter and exit through the arrival court off of the Clayton lot.

- MASKING: Just like at school, when students (and guests) are outside they are not expected to mask, but when inside they must wear their mask.
- MAJOR SCHOOL RULES & DRUG POLICY: Our major rules and drug policy are in effect at all school-sponsored events. Students are responsible for understanding these rules before attending any event. If a student violates one of these rules, they will be asked to give up their car keys, and a parent/guardian will be called to pick up the student. Further disciplinary action will be taken at the appropriate time. For the sake of clarity, to date all disciplinary cases involving the use of illegal drugs have resulted in expulsion, and all disciplinary cases involving alcohol have resulted, at a minimum, in suspension. These policies are in our JBS Family Handbook.
